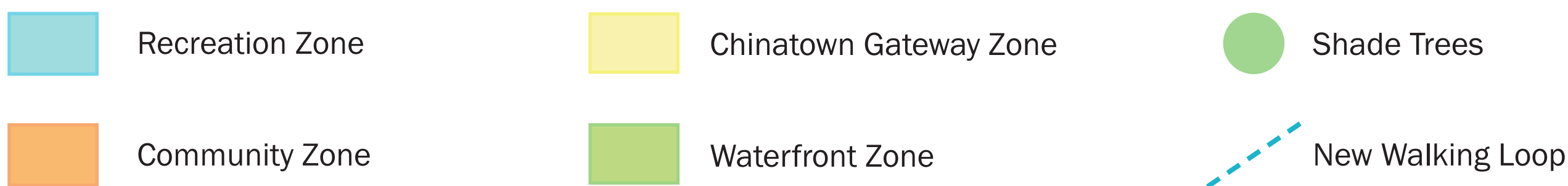
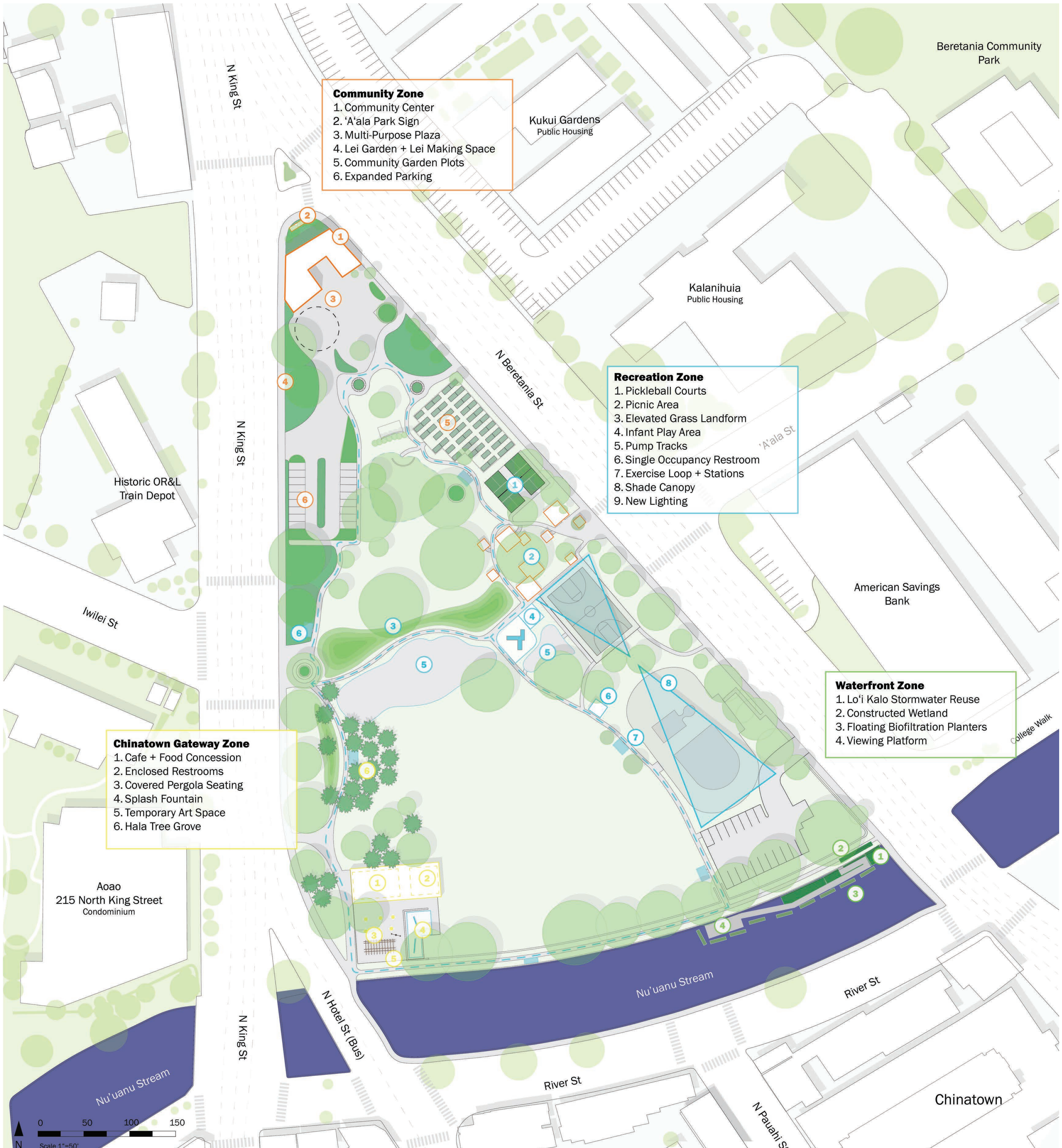

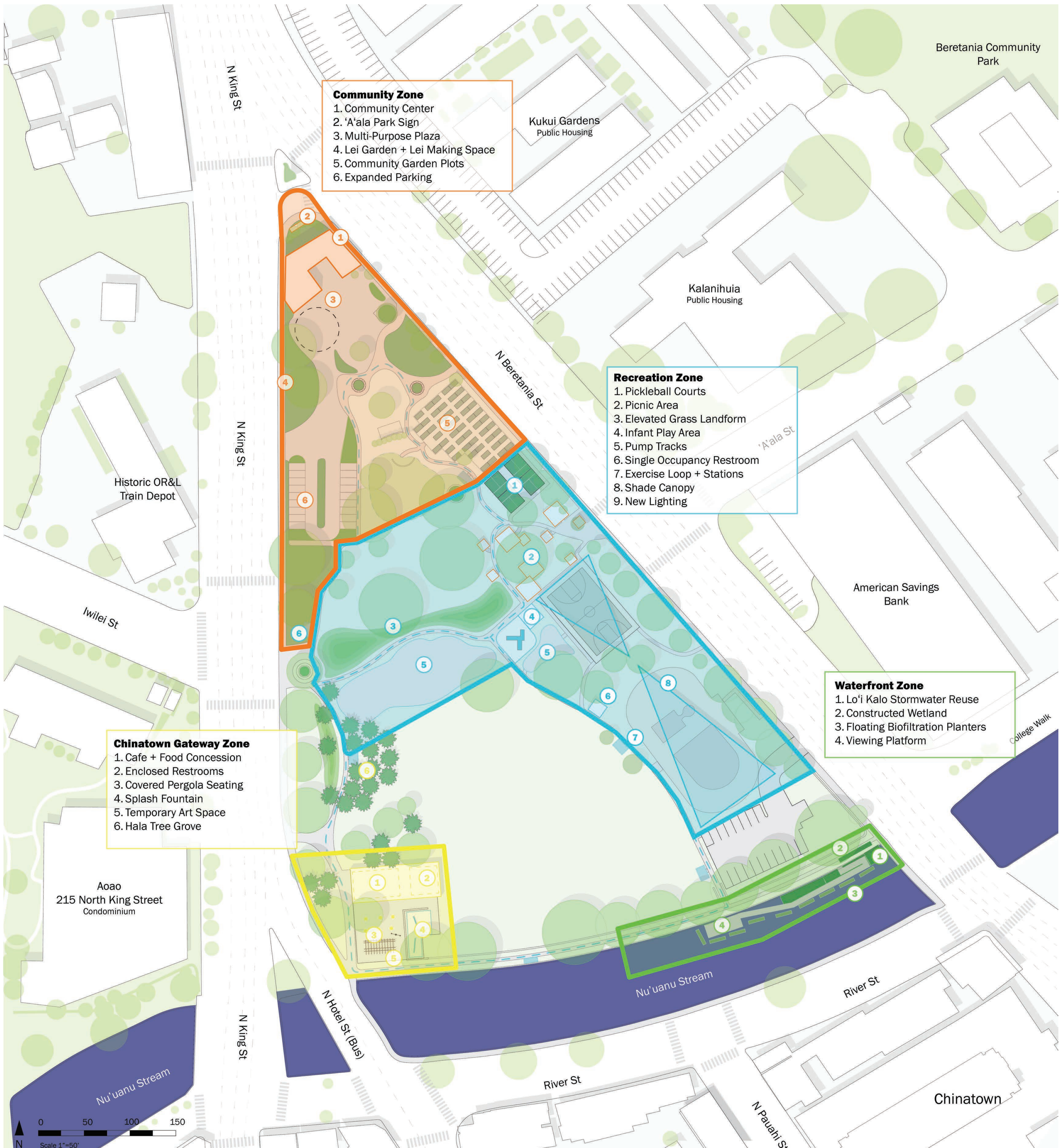
Community Participatory Proof-of-Concept Design

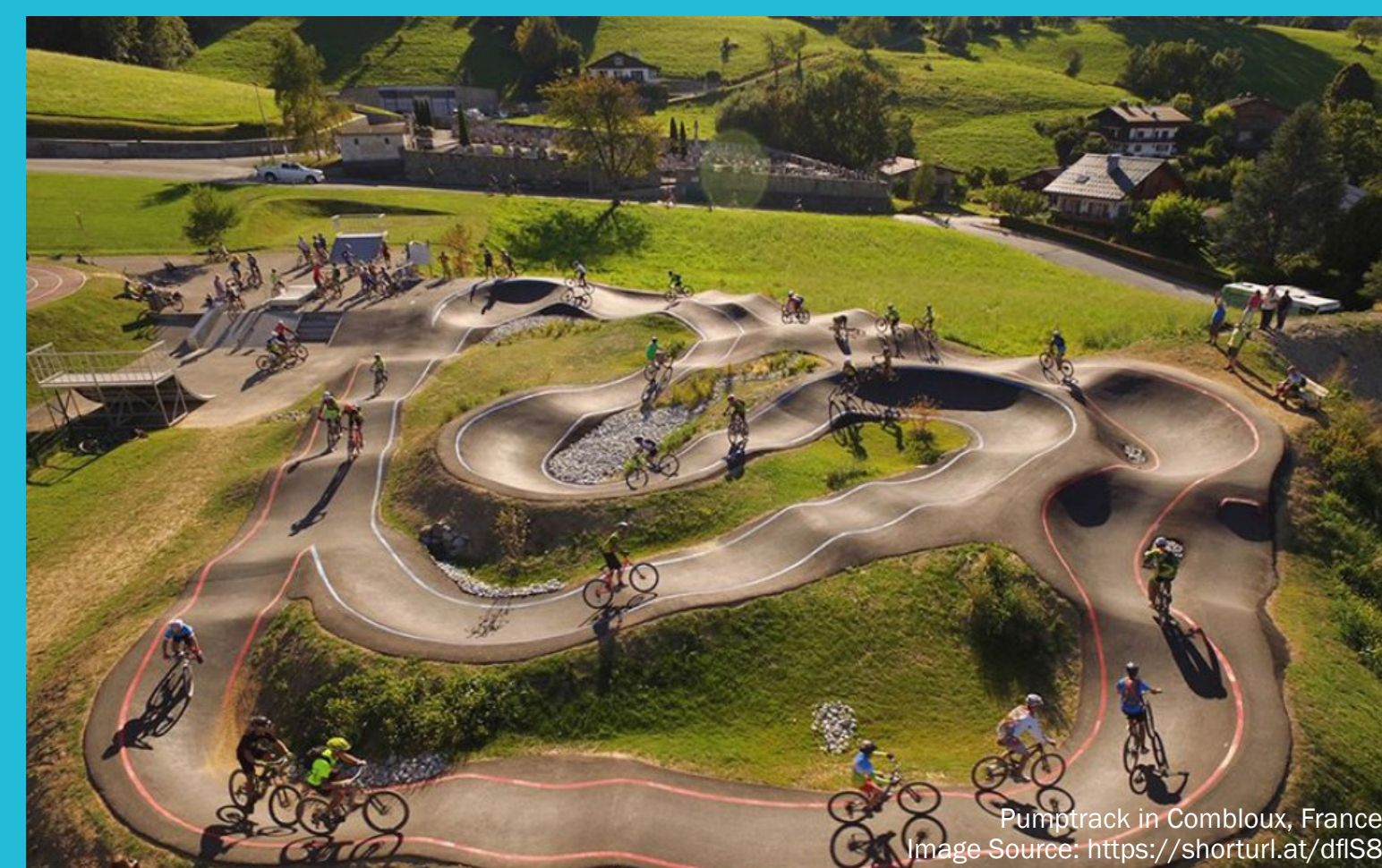

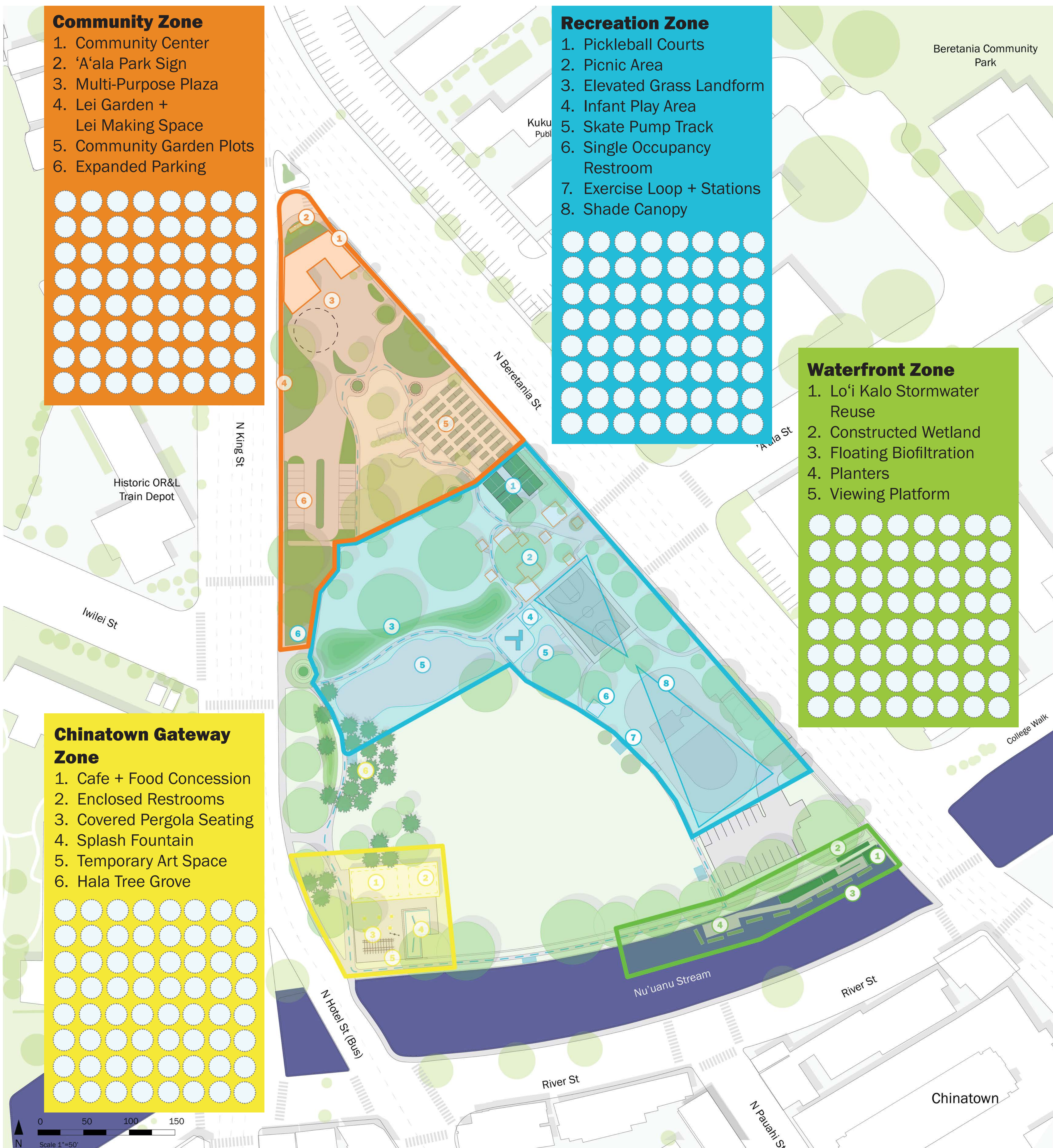

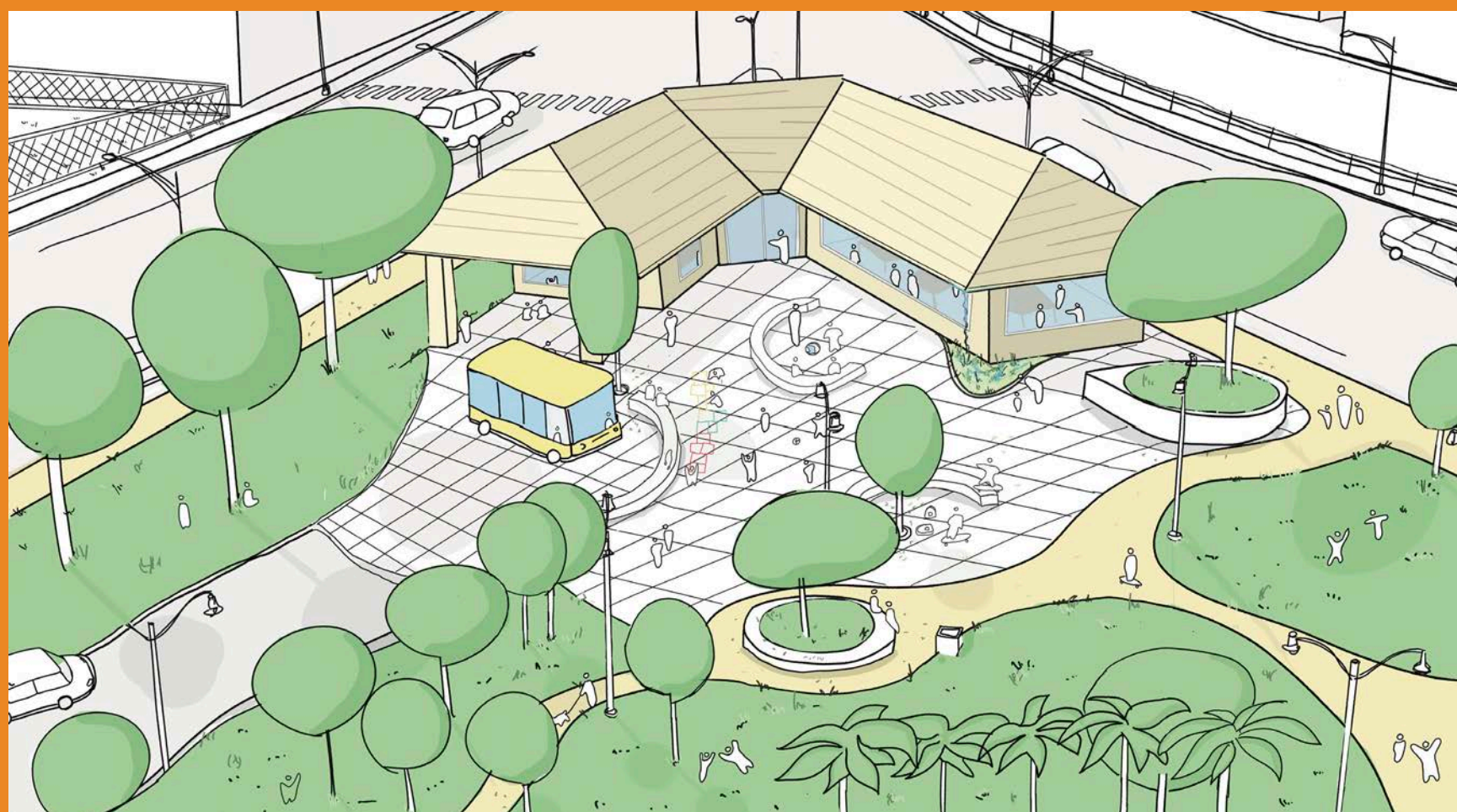
